***Please note the following policies for entering Hong Kong Football Club which is subjected to change according to updates from the Government:***

### ***Mobile Phones***

*Use of mobile phones at the Hong Kong Football Club is prohibited.*

### ***RAT***

***All attendees will have to present proof of a negative Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) taken within 24 hours in order to enter any of the Club's outlets or function rooms. Members and their guests are required to show a photo of the RAT result with the name, date and time the test was taken. A negative PCR taken within the preceding 48 hours can be used as an alternative.***

### ***Leave Home Save App***

*All participants entering the Club must use the Leave Home Safe app and show their vaccination pass with the new health code colours. Persons under the category of Red and Amber Codes are not allowed to enter the Club.*



## **Guest Vaccination**

*All persons entering catering premises must comply with the vaccination requirements, except under exempted scenarios.*
