Hong Kong Court Judgments on Financial Mis-selling Claims

Financial mis-selling became a hot topic after the Lehman

Minibond crisis in 2008 and made its way to the SFC "watchlist". Regulators have made multiple efforts to combat such conduct. However, what are the chances of getting your money back?

In this webinar, Partner Kenix Yuen and Associate Adrian Li from dispute resolution firm Gall will give an update on recent Hong Kong judgments for financial mis-selling claims and will provide a general overview of how Hong Kong Courts have decided on these types of cases.
